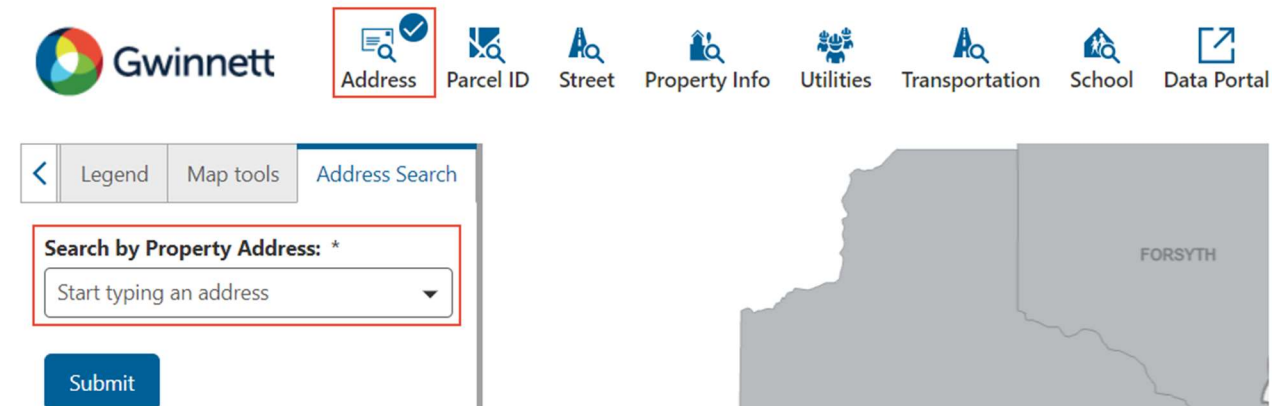

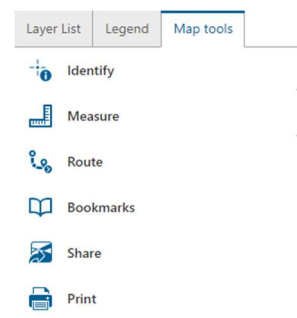
How To Search for an Address

1. Select the “Address” search button located on the top “Search” panel.
2. A new tab, containing a text box, will appear in the left panel, called “Address search”.
3. Start typing the address into the text box and select one of the autocomplete suggestions.
4. Click Submit.
5. A new tab, containing the address search results, will appear in the left panel, called “Results”.
6. Select the search result for a more detailed view of the data.
7. Exit out of the “Results” tab to clear all results from the map.
