Gwinnett County Public Library has launched a program that allows homebound patrons to access library materials and have them delivered to their home for free. Called Mailbox Books, the service is designed for people who can't visit the library because of age, physical disability, chronic illness, visual impairment, or a temporary condition that renders them homebound. Users will receive the Best Readers' Advisory and customer assistance. Staff will help patrons locate books in their preferred format, such as regular print, large print, DVD, or CD books. 


located at 6160 Crescent Drive in Norcross. The South Precinct in Lilburn and the Central Precinct in Duluth have also reopened.
