Commissioner Ku to host State of District 2 on August 29
District 2 Commissioner Ben Ku is holding a town hall on Thursday,
August 29 from 6:00pm to 7:00pm at the Mountain Park Activity
Building, located at 1063 Rockbridge Road in Stone Mountain.

Commissioner Ku will share updates on District 2 and Countywide projects, including new community services projects, housing initiatives, the transit referendum, and improved innovation and engagement.

There will also be an opportunity for a Q&A session with County representatives, with an ASL translator present.

Atlanta Regional Commission seeks input on Participation Plan update

Residents are encouraged to provide input on a major update to the Atlanta Regional Commission's regional public participation plan. This update is the first since 2019 and is designed to ensure that ARC's transportation planning meets the region's needs and reflects metro Atlanta's diverse population.

Residents can provide input by taking an <u>online survey</u>, visiting the <u>ARC website</u>, or attending <u>in-person events</u> in August and September to review the draft plan and offer comments.

Gwinnett becomes first metro Atlanta gold-tier BioReady® community

At a recent Board of Commissioners meeting, Gwinnett County received a plaque for achieving gold status as a BioReady® community from Georgia Bio, the state's leading life sciences membership organization.

The BioReady® program rates communities in three tiers: Bronze, Silver and Gold. These ratings assess a municipality's readiness to host biotechnology facilities based on zoning practices and infrastructure capacity, helping real estate developers and biotechnology companies find the most favorable destinations to locate.
