One of my District 4 initiatives is voter outreach, and to help with that, I'll be speaking at pop-up community meetings over the next few months to keep voters informed on what is happening in our County.

The focus will be about the upcoming transit referendum on the November 5 General Election ballot.

Voters will decide whether to fund transit projects through a dedicated Transit Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax, known as a Transit SPLOST. If approved, this would implement a one percent sales tax for 30 years to support up to 75 transit projects in Gwinnett.

I'd love to come speak to your group – whether it's your HOA, Rotary Club, Kiwanis Club, or any other group you can gather! My goal is to get a minimum of 10 people in the room.

Gwinnett becomes first metro Atlanta gold-tier BioReady® community

At a recent Board of Commissioners meeting, Gwinnett County received a plaque for achieving gold status as a BioReady® community from Georgia Bio, the state's leading life sciences membership organization.

The BioReady® program rates communities in three tiers: Bronze, Silver and Gold. These ratings assess a municipality's readiness to host biotechnology facilities based on zoning practices and infrastructure capacity, helping real estate developers and biotechnology companies

find the most favorable destinations to locate.

Atlanta Regional Commission seeks input on Participation Plan update

Residents are encouraged to provide input on a major update to the Atlanta Regional Commission's regional public participation plan. This update is the first since 2019 and is designed to ensure that ARC's transportation planning meets the region's needs and reflects metro Atlanta's diverse population.

Residents can provide input by taking an <u>online survey</u>, visiting the <u>ARC website</u>, or attending <u>in-person events</u> in August and September to review the draft plan and offer comments.





Nonprofit Capacity Building Grant applications open until August 30

Gwinnett will accept applications for its Nonprofit Capacity Building Grant until August 30. The grant program provides financial assistance to nonprofits negatively affected by the COVID-19 pandemic. This may occur in the form of operational support or capital support. Applications can be accessed in the grant application portal, and applicants must register with GovGrants to submit an application.

The Gwinnett County Board of Commissioners allocated \$5 million in American Rescue Plan Act funding for Nonprofit Capacity Building. In

alignment with the County's <u>Human Services Strategic Plan</u>, funding will be awarded to organizations providing services in food security, housing, health and wellness, youth, literacy, and learning, and cross-cutting barriers to access like transportation or culturally and linguistically responsive services.


