Advanced voting for the General Election is underway

Election Day is Tuesday, November 5. Registered voters can vote in advance every day, including weekends, from now until November 1, between 7:00am and 7:00pm, at various advance voting locations across the county.

Drop off your unused prescriptions during National Drug Take Back

Safely dispose of old and unused prescription medications during the National Drug Take Back Initiative, hosted by the Gwinnett County Police Department and the Drug Enforcement Administration. This initiative aims to prevent drug abuse and overdose in our community.

On **Saturday, October 26**, from **10:00am to 2:00pm**, you can drop off prescription items at Police Headquarters and all police precincts, including the District 4 precinct at **2735 Mall of Georgia Boulevard**, **Buford**.



Accepted items include tablets, capsules, and patches. Please note that liquids, syringes, and sharp objects will not be accepted.
