Recorder's Court is a highvolume court established in 1972 to create a system that would effectively and efficiently process the growing number of traffic cases in Gwinnett County.






Mandated Functions

- Submit dispositions and failure to appear notices to Department of Driver Services
- Retain records according to Georgia Secretary of State
- Submit DUI Publications

- \$78,625 Sherriff's Retirement Fund (O.C.G.A. §§ 47-16-60 and 47-16-61)




Payment Method


- 17,062 web payments
