Overview

Gwinnett County's Board of Commissioners allocated \$5 million in ARPA funds to **support local Nonprofit Organizations (NPOs)** serving Gwinnett residents by offering the **Nonprofit Capacity Building Grant**.



Capital Support

\$4,500,000

Administration: Grants Management Division

Program Timeline: 12 months

Award Value(s): \$3,000 to \$100,000 (one award per NPO)

Payment Terms: Advance funding upon receipt of PO/Contract for capital purchase.

Reporting Requirements: Impact Reporting

Operational Support

\$450,000

Administration: Grants Management Division & NPO Trainers

Program Timeline: 15 months

Award Value(s): \$40,000 (10 participating NPOs)

Payment Terms: Quarterly installments of \$10,000

Reporting Requirements: Capacity Building Project Report

- Nonprofits with 12 months of operation
- Demonstrated history of serving Gwinnett residents
- Experienced negative economic impact due to COVID-19
- Active participation in Unite Us

Operational Support



- All requirements under Capital Support*
- Annual operating budget equal to, or less than, \$250,000
- Commitment to participation in all program components



The Gwinnett County Board of Commissioners allocated \$5 million in American Rescue Plan Act funding for Nonprofit Capacity Building. The objective is to increase the effectiveness and strength of local nonprofits to enhance their impact on our community. This may occur in the form of **operational support** or **capital support**.

In alignment with the County's [Human Services Strategic Plan](#), funding will be given to organizations providing services within the following categories of need:


- Food Security
- Housing
- Health and Wellbeing
- Youth, Literacy, and Learning
- Cross-cutting Barriers to Access
 - Transportation
 - Culturally and Linguistically Responsive Services

The County also intends to prioritize funding to small nonprofits and grassroots organizations working within these priority areas to enhance our community's collective impact. **Small nonprofits and grassroots organizations are identified as organizations with an annual operating budget of up to \$250,000.**
