A new park is coming to Gwinnett

County officials recently broke ground on the future Discovery Park, which will be the 53rd park in Gwinnett Parks and Recreation's system. The park — located at the intersection of Old Norcross and Lawrenceville-Suwanee roads — will offer accessibility and recreational features for park-goers like a lighted multiuse trail, ball fields, an interactive fountain, and an inclusive playground for children of all ages and abilities. Get free plumbing services through the Water Resources Assistance Program



Receive assistance with leaks, septic system repairs, and other plumbing issues through the Water Resources Assistance Program, or WRAP. The program is a partnership between Gwinnett Water Resources and local organizations. WRAP provides eligible homeowners with plumbing services, septic system repair, and water-saving fixtures at no cost. To qualify, applicants must live in Gwinnett County, own and live in the home where the work will occur, and earn an annual household income that is 60 percent of the Area Median Income or less. 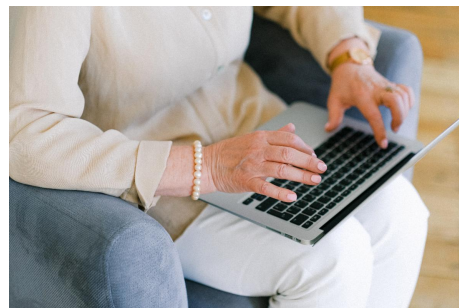
County offices closed for Independence Day
