Stay safe from the storm

Hurricane Helene is forecasted to bring strong winds and rain, leading to potential flooding as well as downed trees and powerlines. Residents are advised to avoid the roads on Friday, September 27 if possible.

Remember these safety tips throughout the storm:

- Monitor the NOAA Weather Radio, or your favorite news source for vital weather related information.
- Bring your pets indoors
- Never touch a downed power line
- If flooding occurs, get to higher ground. Get out of areas subject to flooding.
- Avoid areas already flooded, especially if the water is flowing fast. Do not attempt to cross flowing streams
- Road beds may be washed out under flood waters. Never drive through flooded roadways. If your vehicle is suddenly caught in rising water, leave it immediately and seek higher ground.
- Be especially cautious at night when it is harder to recognize flood dangers
