# Vote early for the General Election

Voters are not limited to Election Day to cast their ballot for the November 5 General Election. Registered voters may vote advance in-person any day, including weekends, through November 1 from 7:00am to 7:00pm at the Gwinnett Voter Registrations and Elections Office in Lawrenceville and 11 other advance voting locations around the county.

Los votantes inscritos pueden votar por adelantado en persona todos los días, incluidos los fines de semana, hasta el **1 de Noviembre de 7:00am a 7:00pm** en la <u>Oficina de Inscripción de Votantes y Elecciones de Gwinnett en Lawrenceville y en otros 11 lugares de votación adelantada</u> en todo el condado.

Gwinnett's Transit Plan includes up to 75 proposed transit projects — including the expansion of our curb-to-curb microtransit service and a direct airport ride to Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport. These proposed transit projects require funding to be implemented.

The <u>transit referendum</u> on the November 5 General Election ballot will allow voters to decide whether to fund these proposed transit projects in Gwinnett's Transit Plan through a one-percent sales tax for 30 years.
