Advance voting for the General Election ends this Friday

Registered voters may vote early in person for the November 5 General Election through **Friday, November 1 from 7:00am to 7:00pm** at the [Gwinnett Voter Registrations and Elections Office in Lawrenceville and 11 other advance voting locations](#) around the county.

Recycle items during America Recycles Day

Residents are invited to recycle household items at America Recycles Day on **Saturday, November 2 from 9:00am to noon** at the Gwinnett County Fairgrounds in Lawrenceville.



Join Gwinnett Solid Waste Management and Gwinnett Clean & Beautiful to drop off electronics, paint, clothing, sneakers, tires, and paper for recycling. Recycling electronics is free except for TVs, monitors, and printers. There is a \$35 cash fee per projection or console TV, a \$15 cash fee per TV or computer monitor, and a \$5 cash fee per printer.

Gwinnett's Transit Referendum is on the General Election ballot

[Gwinnett's Transit Plan](#) includes up to 75 proposed transit projects — including the expansion of our curb-to-curb microtransit service and a direct airport ride to Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport. These projects will require funding for implementation.

On the November 5 General Election ballot, the [transit referendum](#) will allow voters to decide whether to fund these proposed transit projects in Gwinnett's Transit Plan through a one-percent sales tax for 30 years. El [Plan de Transporte Público de Gwinnett](#) incluye hasta 75 proyectos de transporte público propuestos, que incluyen la expansión de nuestro servicio de microtransporte y un servicio directo al Aeropuerto Internacional Hartsfield-Jackson de Atlanta. Estos proyectos requieren financiación para poder llevarse a cabo.

En la boleta electoral de las Elecciones Generales del 5 de Noviembre, el [referendo de transporte público](#) permitirá a los votantes decidir si financiar estos proyectos de tránsito propuestos en el Plan de Transporte Público de Gwinnett a través de un impuesto sobre las ventas del uno por ciento durante 30 años. Head to the polls on Election Day



Voters can cast their ballots on Election Day, **Tuesday, November 5, from 7:00am to 7:00pm** at their assigned polling location. If you are in line at 7:00pm, you will be allowed to vote.

While no voting will take place at the [Voter Registrations and Elections Beauty P. Baldwin Building](#) on Election Day, voted absentee ballots can be mailed or hand-delivered to the building. All absentee ballots must be received in the office by 7:00pm on November 5. Election Day polling locations cannot accept absentee ballots.

There will be no voting on Monday, November 4. Visit the Secretary of State's [My Voter Page](#) to locate your assigned polling location or view a sample ballot.
