Chairwoman Hendrickson presents proposed budget for 2025

Gwinnett County Board of Commissioners Chairwoman Nicole Love Hendrickson presented her proposed budget to guide County government spending for the 2025 fiscal year. The proposed budget for 2025 totals \$2.65 billion. It consists of a \$2.1 billion operating budget and a \$542 million capital improvements budget, which includes funds from the County's Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax program. Chairwoman Hendrickson said the proposed budget addresses challenges facing the County, including health care, affordable housing, and sustainability.



The proposed 2025 budget resolution is <u>available online</u> and as a hard copy in the Financial Services office at the Gwinnett Justice and Administration Center in Lawrenceville during business hours, Monday through Friday from 8:00am until 5:00pm. Commissioners will hold a public hearing on **December 3 at 6:30pm** at in Conference Room C of the Gwinnett Justice and Administration Center. Residents can also offer input on the County's website through December 31. Commissioners will consider the 2025 budget at their first meeting of the new year on January 7.
