Boarding-up a Vacant Structure

In the event a vacant structure must be boarded-up, a permit is required. No one is to place boards or other non-conventional material over the doors, windows or any other opening of any building or structure without first obtaining a boarding-up permit.

How do I obtain a Boarding-up permit?

- ☐ Complete an application form to include:
 - Name, address and phone number of the owner
 - o Name, address and phone number of the local agent
 - Tax parcel identification number
 - o Address of the structure
 - o Security and maintenance plan
 - o A permit fee of \$200.00
 - The permit may be renewed at a cost of \$100.00

☐ What is included in the security and maintenance plan?

- The length of time the owner expects the structure to be boarded.
- o What color of paint will be used?
 - Two coats of paints similar to the main structure is required.
- o How will the structure be secured?

Important Additional information:

- A vacant structure which is boarded-up must also be registered.
 - Vacant structure registration fee is \$100.
- Any boarded-up structure must be posted with the case number, the local agent's name, and the local agents 24 hour contact phone number.
- The county may conduct an inspection to ensure the structure is boarded up in accordance with the security and maintenance plan.

Frequently Asked Questions:

- ☐ If my building or home is damaged by a storm, do I have to obtain a boarding-up permit?
 - A boarding-up permit is not required to board up a structure for 30 days or less in the event of a temporary emergency such as damage cased by vandalism, theft, or weather. If the building is to remain boarded-up for longer than 30 days, a permit will be required.
- Does this ordinance apply to my building if it was already boarded up prior to the adoption of the ordinance?
 - Yes. The ordinance does apply.
- ☐ Do I have to board up my vacant house?
 - No. A vacant house does not have to be boarded-up unless the house cannot be secured through conventional means.
 - o The vacant house must be registered.
