



## **Our Program**

#### Treatment

Children aged 0-17, with a focus on children who have experienced trauma, using evidence-based modalities like CPP, CCPT, TF-IPT, TF-CBT, and others!

#### Training

## **Our Main Modalities**

#### Child-Centered Play Therapy

A developmentally responsive, playbased mental health intervention for young children ages 3 to 10. CCPT utilizes play, the language of children, and therapeutic relationship to provide a safe, consistent therapeutic environment in which a child can experience full acceptance, empathy, and understanding from the counselor and process inner experiences and feelings through play and symbols

**Filial Therapy** 

A modality for caregivers and children ages 3-11 years old in which the caregiver uses CCPT skills to become the change agent for the child and form healthy attachments.

#### Child-Parent Psychotherapy

A dyadic modality for caregivers and children ages 0 - 6 designed to break intergenerational trauma cycles and support healthy attachment between caregiver and child.



(Romanian, Spanish, English, Russian, Urdu)






## **Types of Trauma Treated**

### **Play Training Program**

Play is a child's natural language; therefore, we are seeking to train VPH clinicians and clinicians across Georgia in Play Therapy. Our goal is to train as many clinicians as possible in this powerful modality. We believe doing so will create increased healing and resiliency for families statewide.

In 2025, we are offering 7 play trainings for a total of 42 possible Play **Therapy CEUs!** 



### **Play Training Program**

# Our Training Program began in 2020 and has been steadily growing since.

Last year we trained 269 clinicians across 6 open trainings.

We also hosted multiple in-service training opportunities for VPH clinicians such as: Group Play Therapy, Filial Therapy, C&A Treatment Planning, and TF-IPT.

### Looking to the future...

The training team's goal is to create a standardized curriculum and exceptional internship program that will allow clinicians across the state to successfully pursue their RPT<sup>™</sup>.



### **VA Families**

Children of veterans are often an overlooked intergenerational trauma population.

In the future, the clinical team would like to be able to support these families and the unique difficulties they face.



#### **Prevention**

Finally, the Centerville team would like to focus on prevention.

A person with 4 or more Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs):

- 2.5x the risk of Heart Disease
- 4.5x the risk of depression
- 12x the risk of suicide
- A person with 7 or more ACEs:
- Triple the risk of lung cancer
- 3.5x the risk of heart disease

Life expectancy for individuals with ACE score of 6 or more is 20 years shorter than individuals with a score of 0.

Prevention efforts can significantly reduce the risk of later physical and mental health conditions throughout Georgia's population.
